These products do not have cadmium, lead, mercury, chromium VI, PBB or PBDE, chlorine, iodine, bromine, fluorine, and astatine listed in the raw ingredients. In addition 4 other substances under RoHS3 include Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and **Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)**

The raw materials used in the manufacturing of these products are all TSCA listed. There have been no intentional additions of heavy metals or brominated flame-retardants. The finished label rolls are considered articles when sold.

RoHS2 is an updated / recast version of RoHS. There are no additions to or difference in the six restricted substances. However, there is a proposed inclusion of Category 8 (medical devices from 2014) and Category 9 (control and monitoring instruments from 2014) and also a new Category 11, which captures all other 'grey area' electrical equipment(from 2019), and Incorporates new CE Marking requirements. The date of this proposed inclusion is 2012 or later.

Note that our compliance statement is based on a review of available MSDSs for the ingredients associated with our finished products provided by our suppliers.
